WHAT?

HW is a creative and foresight studio that imagines new formats of art projects to increase the sensitivity of all the senses of the participants (artists and audience), such as sight, sound, touch and smell. Founded in 2019 in the multicultural Berlin, HW* is an independent research and experimentation platform that produces fieldwork on artists struggles, podcasts, digital projects, festival of performances, exhibitions, residency programs.

WHY?

- > We Investigate : About women artists' struggles in countries in crisis.
- > We Produce: LIVE & ONLINE projects about real intimacy.
- > We Connect: People that can't travel, to deconstruct ethnocentrism.
- > We Empower: Talented Artists who create secretly and who never got grants.
- We Learn: Through art residencies, exchanging skills, and knowledge.
 We Create: Artworks with a specific curatorial method to get people closer.
- > We Heal: Our projects are devoted to emotional processing & collective healing.

HOW?

Our artistic line is to focus on collecting, sharing and creating on intimate stories to connect people deeper. Until now, HW is producing 3 projects

- The Enclosed Garden (TEG): the annual & nomadic festival of performances & visual arts for women.
- The Eddies a series of posts (texts, sounds, videos) about their fieldwork on women artists struggles in countries where TEG happened and,
- The Wielaye, a podcast program on queer intimate stories.





CURATION

<<I am a researcher-curator* who has been exploring different ways of reinvigorating exhibition formats in contrast to the traditional collectionscentred museum models. To me, exhibitions can play a massive role in how we learn how to create a community. Therefore, I am interested in solo exhibitions or solo artists' processes of work; I rather stimulate collective projects. >>

*For me being a curator is about merging my four professions in one: a researcher, a designer of spaces, a mediator, a choreographer.

I design multisensory labyrinths, a series of alcoves, where every artwork can be touched, smelts, listened to bring the body (of the audience & the artists) to the core of exhibition format. I have to live with the artists to perceive how to weave their unique languages, and be able to design an exhibition journey made of several personalities that dialogue with each other in a coherent & harmonious whole. At the beginning of the retreat, I share resources about the exhibition's theme, and coordinate research collective brainstorming. Later I write the curatorial statement and create a video art about the exhibition process.

<< After 15 years of working for museums, dance companies and music ensembles, I have mixed several approaches to bring the audience's body to the core of my exhibition device. Far from the clinical white cube format, the visitor's body is immersed in a labyrinth of spontaneous artistic proposals that grow 3 weeks before during an intensive art residency. This brand new format of exhibition is called an EXPLOSITION. It's an exhibition of visual & sound artists who perform live their freshly created artworks in front of the audience.</p>

Every year, the project selects womxn from all over the world and takes place in countries where artists struggle to get paid and create freely on self-reflection and emotional processes.>>


CURATORIAL STATEMENT





Salomé Jashi's new film, to be released in 2021, portrays a capricious pursuit of Bidzina Ivanishvili, a wealthy man and former prime minister of Georgia, who still rules the country from the shadows. He collects century-old trees, as tall as ten-floor buildings. His men uproot them along the coastline of Georgia and bring them to his private garden. The route lies through villages, forests and the Black Sea.

Before the film is released, Salomé Jashi has invited two collaborators – soundscape composer Diane Barbé and researcher Celia Stroom – to develop an art experience. An orchestra of altered field recordings, a video installation, photographs, texts of literature and dialogues of witnesses affected by the vicious project explore the film material in a multimedia and multisensory setting. The team proposes a surrealistic world order where reality has flipped, where nothing is stable and predictable. The different mediums are not additions of layers; rather, they are in fusion.

At the entrance the journey starts with a sound bath. Machines, insects, people, birds, trees are all stakeholders — but the voices of this polyphony orchestrated by Diane Barbé are not heard until we make a conscious effort to hear them. The audience starts the exploration by discovering photographs by Celia Stroom who has documented the filming session as well as extracts from dialogues of the witnesses whose trees were taken away. These elements mirror Salomé Jashi's video depicting uprooting and transportation juxtaposed with ordinary life happening like fishing.


In Vanity by the See one element invades the other. And the perception of what is happening depends on the audience actively engaging in listening and reading. Here trees are moving, floating, sobbing, while humans are still, locked down in a deep despair. Like in Dulle Griet (Mad Meg) by Pieter Bruegel the Elder, this experience tries to appeal to all the senses in order to arouse anxiety, melancholy and create pleasure at the same time. The crooked perception of what reality is constitutes the core of the new film of Salomé Jashi.

THE ENCLOSED GARDEN #1 2019 - GEORGIA


<< I have spent 5 years in Georgia, first as an</p> ethnomusicologist who was conducting a research on forgotten polyphonies. I have been recording, writing, learning songs for few years travelling through the whole country. I later started to live in Tbilisi. I have been performing and exhibiting my installations (cf. L'OEIL ECOUTE), I also became the close collaborator Salome Jashi with whom I was working full time on 2 projects. The film Taming the garden and the exhibition The Enclosed Garden.>>

Curator's note

" In a world governed by the excess communication. what place is granted to the intimate, its hidden witnesses, its corners of velvet and its secret tears? Is there a place to deposit the treasure of our fantasies and the richness of our singularity? The space of the exhibition THE ENCLOSED GARDEN carries this function. The curator has chosen to transform an empty flat, an intimate area of an immense building, a place where secrets have been exchanged, where one can isolate oneself, and feel free in a dark labyrinth.

The challenge of Heroines is to gather women who never met before and to provoke a catharsis in the mind of each artist. After days of intense exploration of our doubts, emotions, hidden thoughts during the residency in Art Garikula, we created a brand new kind of exhibition. In each room you feel at home, in the "room of one's own" of Virginia Woolf. 12 rooms, or enclosed gardens, represent the allegory of the Self. We have been living in this empty apartment for few days. It became our intimate space. In each room, you can immerse yourself in a dialogue between painting, vocal polyphony, installations, videos, photos, drawings, sound creations, expressive and twirling bodies, texts and even perfumes.

We observe intimacy in a spatial form, an inside separated from the outside. Here we tickle the boundaries between private and public, singular and plural, loneliness, observing modesty and shame in the face of vulgarity and obscenity. In this Enclosed Garden, everyone can loose themselves or find themselves. It is the place where you feel safe or hidden inside your psychological fences, this space from which you sometimes want to escape and discover the wild world beyond our own borders. Welcome in our home. "



ART DIRECTION of PERFORMANCES/ INSTALLATIONS

<< I create installations, performances, soundscapes vocal experiences. Each artwork aims at stimulating intimate, complex and unsettling feelings, seeking access to letting go and trance.

What do I create? I would not speak about medium, as I use many of them, I'd rather describe my artworks as multimedia cabinets of curiosities, a space, a volume, a perimeter within which a surreal, noetic and highly sensorial world floods the visitor's perceptive system. I have been trained initially as a dancer, singer and visual artist. Performing arts is my main way of expression. >>






This soft material, full of intimate fragrance is welcoming the audience in a huge vagina.
